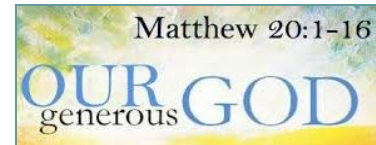
Region Two Vision Statement

When have your actions not measured up to your promises? What was the outcome?

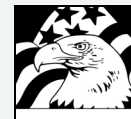

As an additional safeguard, the hotline is administered by an independent third-party company, EthicsPoint. 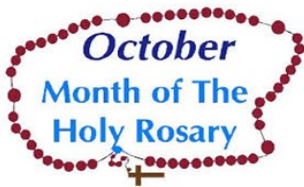
