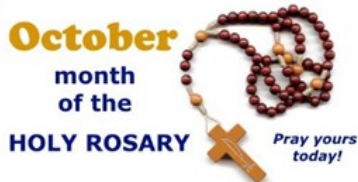

THE BIBLE AND THE SACRAMENTS

The Bible and the Sacraments is the fifth in the Journey Through Scripture series of Bible studies written by Dr. Scott Hahn and the St. Paul Center for Biblical Studies. This is the second of the series to have been transformed from the Presenter/ Power point format to a video presentation. MATER FILIUS

Mater Filius, the ministry that is setting up the home for Homeless Pregnant Ladies in the former QM rectory, is looking for volunteers on the following areas: Board of Advisors and Teachers.

The Board of Advisors will be responsible for developing fundraising activities, identifying new volunteers, and to help set policies for the house.

Teachers will be needed in all areas of training for the young women to become productive members of our community. There will be training in housekeeping, parenting, infant care, obtaining a GED, college and career counseling. We will also need individuals who can teach various courses in catechesis. There is a volunteer signup sheet in the Narthex of QM.

If you are a married couple and would be interested in being the primary directors for this house, which involves being trained in how a Mater Filius House is operated and the rules that need to be in place and be enforced, please contact Maria Resendiz directly at 513-260-8055.

We are also in need of a single woman who would like to be a House Mom, that we call Ima. This individual would live in the Home, be paid a salary and be responsible for taking care of the home and the ministry at the point of contact with the Ladies. JOY OF THE GOSPEL
