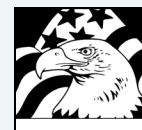

FINANCIAL MISCONDUCT HOTLINE

In a spirit of good stewardship, the Archdiocese of Cincinnati has instituted a financial misconduct hotline to allow employees, volunteers, vendors and other interested parties to report what they believe to be financial misconduct at any level—parish, deanery or Archdiocese. As an additional safeguard, the hotline is administered by an independent third-party company, EthicsPoint. **QM ST. VINCENT de PAUL CONFERENCE
YEAR END REPORT**

Our conference, thanks to your support, helped 345 families in 2017 comprised of 678 adults and 364 children, for a total of 1042 people in our community.

We provided 82 families with beds and furniture at a cost of \$10,054. We helped 15 families with rent for a total of \$3019. We helped 210 families with utilities at a cost of \$22,074. We gave out Kroger and Wal-Mart cards to 14 families at a cost of \$725. We gave 4 families bus tokens and supplied appliances for 1 family at a cost of \$353. We helped 15 families with clothing vouchers and helped 1 family with fuel for their car, so they could get to work.

The total we spent for the year was \$36,206, an increase of almost \$3,000 from 2016.

I ask that you keep our conference members in your prayers. They work very hard, serving our neighbors in their time of need.

Again, on behalf of the families that you helped, Queen of Martyrs SVDP Conference thanks you for your support this past year and your continuing support in the future.

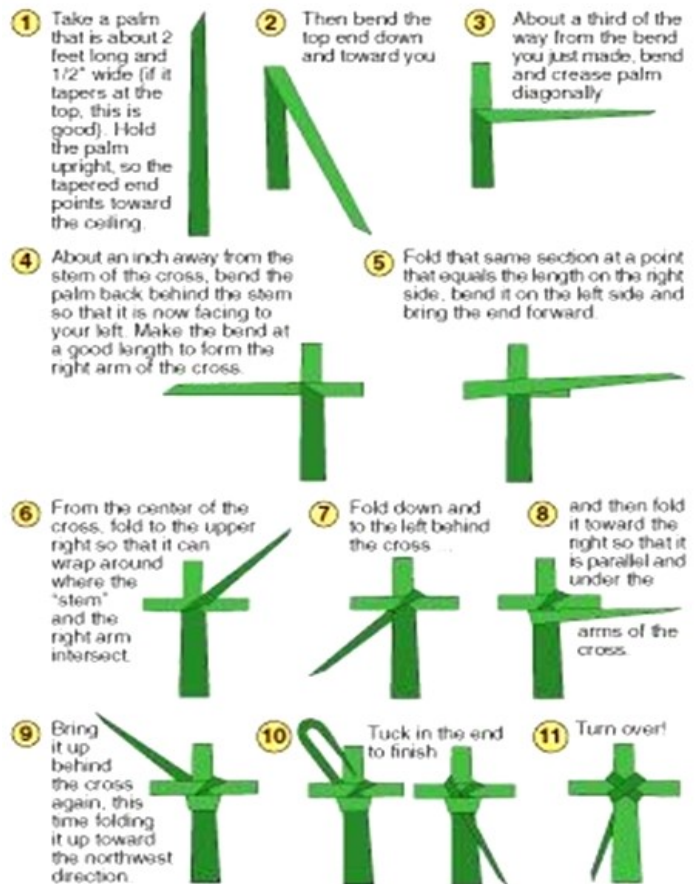
HOLY WEEK SERVICES
