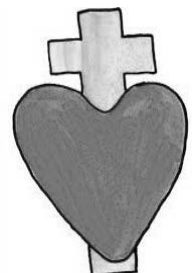

As an additional safeguard, the hotline is administered by an independent third-party company, EthicsPoint.
