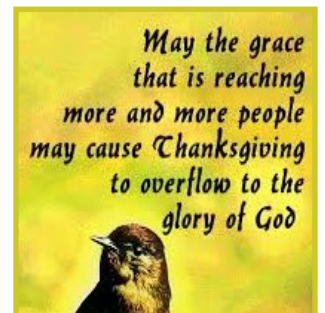

FINANCIAL MISCONDUCT HOTLINE

In a spirit of good stewardship, the Archdiocese of Cincinnati has instituted a financial misconduct hotline to allow employees, volunteers, vendors and other interested parties to report what they believe to be financial misconduct at any level—parish, deanery or Archdiocese. As an additional safeguard, the hotline is administered by an independent third-party company, EthicsPoint. Any individual may report a concern on this hotline either by calling one of EthicsPoint's trained specialists at 1-888-389-0381 or by visiting the website www.ethicspoint.com.
